Game Chart Layout

Shot Clock, Game Clock and Period
Tap to start clock or change. Tap the down arrow button to subtract time

Possession: The ball represents possession. Tap the ball to change possession

Actions Button:
Start and Restart Game, View/Email Reports in this option

Reset Button:
Reset Scoreboard, Player Stats, Shot Clock, Play-by-Play, etc.

Ball under jersey indicates player is selected. Name displays below on court players

Game Actions:
Actions that have happened in the game. Just select a player, tap on the court and select an action. Score and stats are updated automatically

Players currently on the court. Tap "Sub" to substitute players in and out of the game

Selected Court: NBA, NCAA, FIBA, HS, or Custom Court



Adding Teams and Ballers

Tap "Edit" to delete teams

Tap "Add Team" to Add a new Team

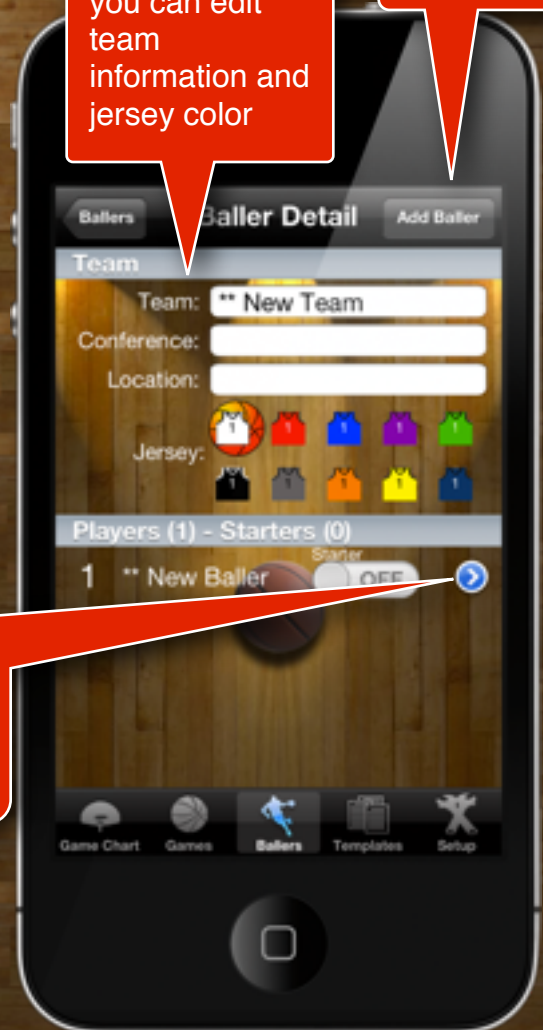
Touch here to edit an already created team's information

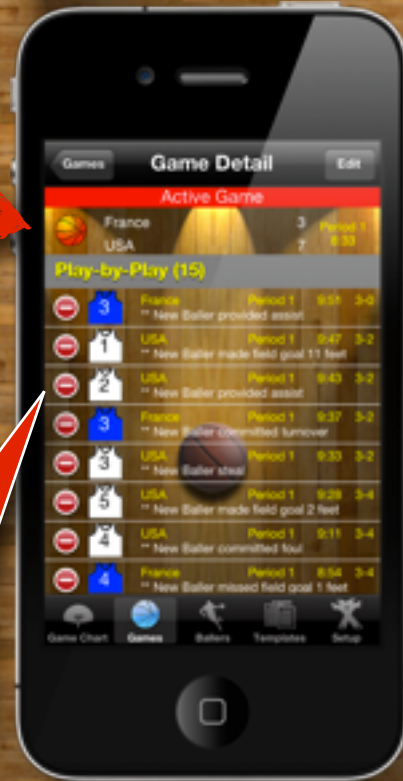
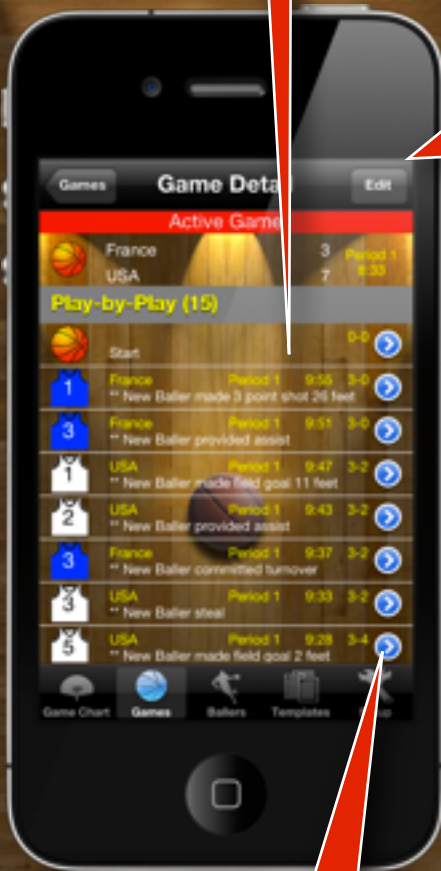

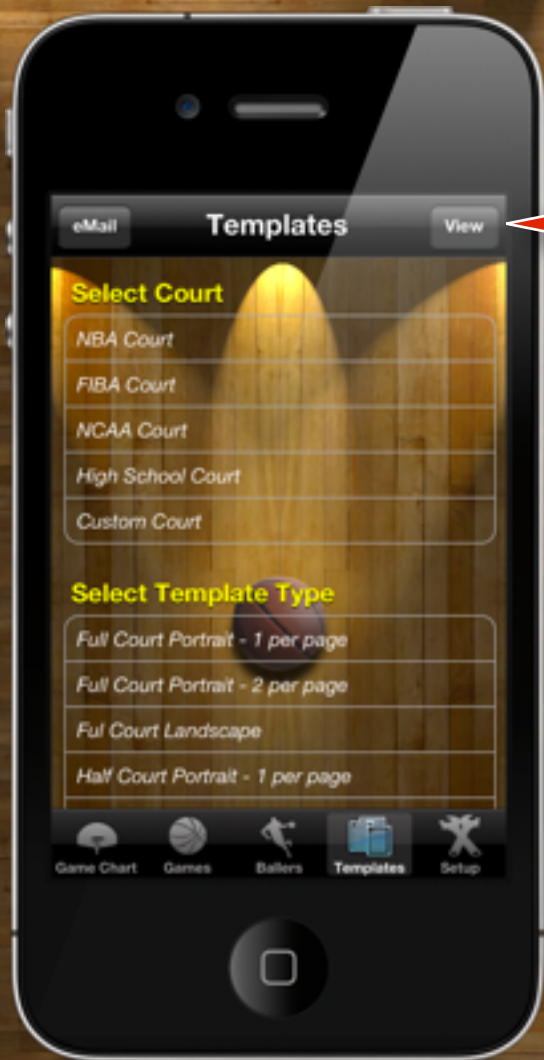

Select the court and template type that you would like to view or email. After selecting, tap email or view



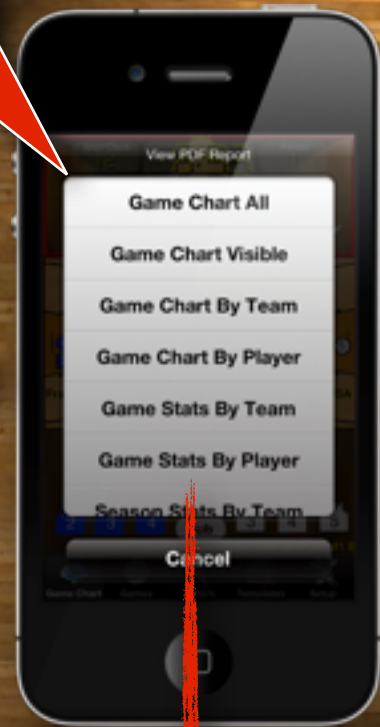
This is an example of a court template. NBA court; Full Court Portrait - 1 per page
